**Stage 1: Shortlisting based on CAT-2016 percentiles**

Candidates will be shortlisted for Stage-2 on the basis of CAT 2016 percentiles as mentioned below:

**Stage 2: Generation of merit list for final selection**

Only the Candidates securing the above mentioned minimum percentile in each category in CAT 2016 will be considered for calculation of their composite score in Stage 2 on the basis of the factors as described in Table 2. Candidates will be offered admission in the order of the merit list based on this composite score.
